

[Academics] Course Instruction for Spring 2021

To ensure the quality of education while conforming to the social distancing guidelines and government regulations, the plan for course instruction for Spring 2021 at Ewha is as follows:

1. General Rule

*As there is no limit on number of enrolled students for The Graduate School courses, courses with more than 50 students enrolled will be switched to online only.

- From 2021.1.15.(Fri), you can check the instruction formats for each course via [Academics>Course Schedule/Syllabus](#) on school's website.

- Course instruction formats may change depending on COVID-19 situation (phase).
If social distancing level is 2.5 or above, all courses are switched to online only.

2. Hybrid (In-person + online) Course Details

Instruction Format (Faculty)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Conducted in-person in assigned classroom during assigned time Conducted via online platform in real time for students taking class remotely (synchronous) or record lecture and upload video file afterwards (asynchronous) (ZOOM support to be provided)
Attendance (Students)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Choose between attending in-person class or taking class online* ※ Neither option will cause any disadvantage to a student's grade or attendance

* Selection of the attendance option (in-person/online) will be arranged separately after the course registration period has ended (details to be announced later).

- Courses of which no one chose in-person attendance option after the final selection period will be switched to online only class.

- If the final number of enrolled students for theory, theory/practice course is 50 or more after the registration change (add/drop) period even though the student quota for the course is 50 or less, the

course will be switched to online only class.

- Theory and theory/practice courses with less than 50 registered students may convert to being conducted online only or in-person only, or any other more efficient instruction method, if: 1) there is a mutual agreement between the instructor and students, and 2) the dean has approved of the change after consideration of the course type, quality, availability of classrooms.
- For classes that include lab experiments, practice or training that require students to take class in-person (requiring use of university facilities such as experimental or practice equipment), in-person classes may be held during the times notified in advance by the course instructor upon receiving approval from the dean. However, efforts will be made to make accommodations for students whose travel or living conditions restrict their availability to come to campus, or who are at risk of exposure to possible infection, etc.

3. Online Course Details

- In accordance with university regulations on remote teaching and learning, online courses will be composed of the following:

**PPT+supplemental material
(instructor voice recording)**

or

Video lectures*



Online learning activities

- Online Q&A chats
- Online discussions
- Check understanding of content through quiz etc.

***Criteria for Online (Video) Lecture**

- **Must be one of the following:** ① **synchronous online class**, ② **lecture video recorded by instructor (asynchronous)** ③ **a combination of the above**
- At least 30% of lecture content must be updated or renewed at the beginning of each year

4. Mid-term/Final Exams

- Exams will be conducted at the discretion of the course instructor in compliance with university regulations, and may be changed depending on COVID-19 situation.

<Ewha Womans University Regulations>

Article 38 (Examinations) ① Examinations must be conducted regularly for each course, mid-term and at the end of each semester. However, depending on the course, examinations may not take place or may be replaced with temporary examinations. (amended 2016.6.16.)

② Examinations may be conducted in written or oral format, replaced with submission of assignments, or conducted in other methods, at the discretion of the course instructor (added 2016.6.16.)
