#### Adaptation Support Programs



Title	Period	Main contents
Orientation for Incoming International Students	One week before course registration period	Information on immigration for incoming international students, Residence Card and Visa issuance, academic guidance (academic schedule, course registration, grading system, required courses, Korean language courses, etc), school portal use, school facilities, scholarships, issuance of student ID and insurance, issuance of various certificates, cultural events for international students, crime prevention guide.
Ewha Mate (Mentoring Program for Degree-Seeking Students)	Every semester	A mentoring program pairs new incoming degree-seeking undergraduate students with current Ewha students to help them settle in Korea and adjust to life at Ewha
Course Registration Support Service	First week of each semester	Volunteer students at Ewha help international students register for courses during the course add & drop period.
Management of students' TOPIK scores	After TOPIK results are announced	Encouraging international students to get higher levels in their TOPIK exams by financially supporting them with TOPIK application fee.
	Always	Support or taking TOPIK preparation class offered by the Ewha Language Center, thereby assisting students in obtaining a higher level of TOPIK score.
Support for meetings with International Students	Once per semester/ Organized by each college and graduate school	Financial support for meetings among professors or staff members from each college (by college unit or department) or graduate school with international students.

#### Daily Life Support Programs



Title	Period	Main contents
Insurance Enrollment Desk	First week of each semester	Every semester the ISAT runs a private insurance enrollment desk with the insurance company in order to ensure international students' safety in Korea.
On-campus Visa Extension Service	Second week of each semester	A service provided by the ISAT in which the university applies for international, exchange, and visiting students' visa extension.
Happy Hour	1~2 times / semester	A gathering event provided by the ISAT for international students to mingle with other students in order to help them feel a sense of belonging to Ewha.
Korean Culture Programs	1~2 times / semester	Korean Cultural experiences for international students and exchange students (Cooking class, movies, K-POP dance class, Samulnori experience (Korean percussion music), Gyeongbokgung Tour (Korean Palace tour), and etc.)
Ewha 101	1~2 times / semester	Helping students to learn about important matters they should be aware of as international students through an easy quiz about sojourn in Korea, academic affairs and etc.

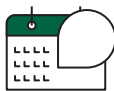
### EAASIS independent majors' program (According to the assigned professor and teaching assistant)

- EAASIS mentoring program (Meetings between mentor and mentees, support for mentoring activities, programs vary among majors)
- Special lectures and events are held based on the characteristics of each department (writing a thesis, career paths related to each major, and special lectures for graduates related to current trends, different kinds of exchange events, etc).
- Development of each department's website in Chinese and production of academic materials in English/Chinese as well as academic support materials for international students from each department.
- Meetings for international students (held by each department: orientation for incoming students, academic information, meetings with professors, etc)

### EAASIS Programs for All International Students

- EAASIS Mentoring program by matching mentor students in the same department with enrolled international students except for students from the EAASIS independent majors.(EAASIS mentor orientation, Activity support fee, etc)
- Special lectures and gathering events related to campus life and career paths (Get together, Special Lecture for Successful Employment in Korea, Career Special Lecture, EAASIS WEEK, etc)
- EAASIS basic Korean/English programs to support international students' Korean/English learning.**
- EAASIS 1:1 Korean Clinic Program: text proofreading, interview· presentation and speaking practice.**

## Visa and Immigration Support

Spring Semester	Fall Semester	Main contents
December of the previous year -February	June - August	- Guidance to leave of absence and return from leave during vacations - Issuance of Certificate of Admission(undergraduate-general graduate school, professional-special graduate school: for freshmen, returning students and readmitted students) - Visa guidance to course completion/graduation - Visa extension notification for those whose visa is expected to expire in March/September.
During the semester	During the semester	- Report on changes in academic status (graduation/completion/dismissal/leave of absence and etc.) - Guidance for foreigner registration upon issuance or re-issuance of visa - On-campus visa extension service - Confirmation of documents for the immigration office (documents for visa extension, part-time job application and etc)
