Eligibility to Apply

Nationality

Female foreign nationals, whose both parents have foreign nationality

Language Proficiency Requirement

Applicants must meet one of the following language requirements:

1. Korean: TOPIK (Test of Proficiency in Korean) level 3 for undergraduate, and level 4 for transfer students or graduate students
2. Completing level 4 or above of Korean Language Intensive Program in Ewha Language Center
3. English: TOEFL(iBT) 80, IELTS 5.5, TEPS 600
4. High school diploma or bachelor's degree from Korean or English speaking institutions
5. Recognition as possessing sufficient proficiency in Korean or English language by Ewha Womans University

Required Documents

1. Online Application Form
2. Application Supplement: Personal Statement & Study Plan
3. Official Transcript of Academic Records
4. Certificate of (prospective) Diploma
5. Certificate proving language proficiency
6. Documents verifying foreign nationality of applicant and both parents
7. Legal document indicating the relationship between the applicant and both parents
8. Certificate authenticating bank balance (USD 20,000 or higher)
9. Materials verifying the applicant's artistic or athletic ability
