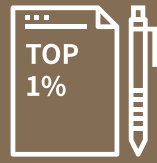

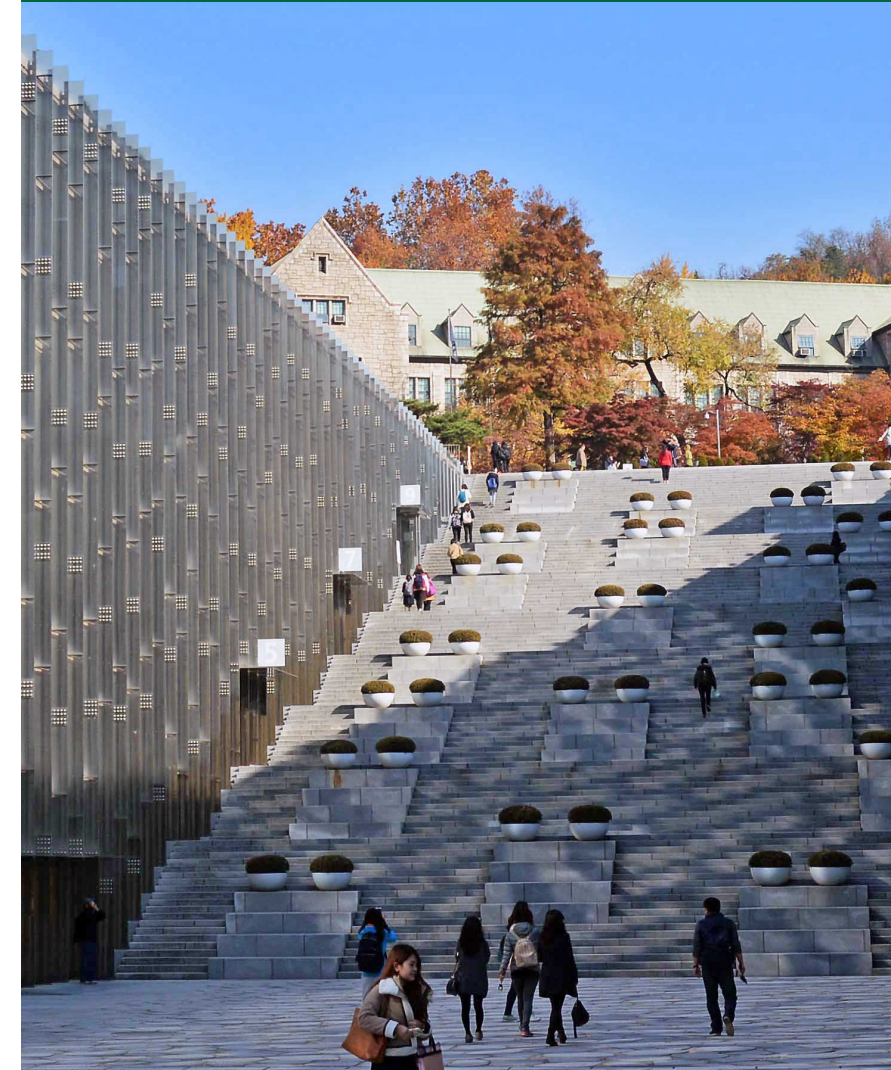

## Eligibility

### Nationality

Female Foreign nationals; both parents must also be foreign nationals

## Language Proficiency Requirements

### Undergraduate Program (Freshman)

A. Departments other than the Division of International Studies: There are no language proficiency requirements for admission. However, students must take Korean language courses upon admission.

B. Division of International Studies: Applicants must meet at least one of the English requirements below.

- English Proficiency Test Scores: TOEFL iBT 80, IELTS 6.0, New TEPS 326 or above
- Completion of high school education conducted entirely in English

### Undergraduate Program (Transfer), Graduate Program

Applicants must meet at least one of the following language proficiency requirements

- TOPIK level 4 or above
- Completion of a Korean Language Program (Level 4 or above) at a Korean language institute affiliated with a university in Korea
- English Proficiency Test Scores: TOEFL iBT 80, IELTS 6.0, New TEPS 326 or above
- Completion of education conducted entirely in Korean or English

※ Applicants to the Division of International Studies must meet at least one of the C-D English requirements.
